His capabilities have helped to gain support for complex projects in Micro Credit and building schools for the rural poor but needy children in the Baika-Buem communities in the Volta Region of Ghana. He turned poverty gridlock into partnerships, while at the same time advocating for the poor on the corridors of the world powers. Through Dr. Arnold's efforts with the local government, an agreement was forged that the model of the BUEMAN MICRO CREDIT **COOPERATIVE SOCIETY** will be replicated in the whole county. His skill and perseverance have produced successful solutions to difficult issues.
